

## EROSION CONTROL NOTICE

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The City of Glenpool has a comprehensive ordinance addressing erosion control. All builders and developers are required to maintain effective erosion control measures **at all times** during construction projects. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Silt, dirt and debris retention on individual lots as well as the boundaries of the overall project.
- Areas under development must have a stabilized construction entrance that is maintained regularly.
- Temporary erosion control measures around all storm sewer structures subject to stormwater runoff during construction.
- Any dirt, silt or debris tracked onto a public street must be immediately removed.

The City does not have a specific prescribed method for erosion control, but the ordinance does require any method used to be effective, and to be repaired and maintained as necessary.

Failure to maintain erosion control on your project not only violates local ordinances, it violates State Statute enforced by the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality concerning stormwater runoff. Failure to comply with erosion control requirements could result in a stop work order or any other remedies allowed by statute.
