



Funded Grants

In May, the Foundation Board meets to review grant applications from school staff. Applications include ideas for creative classroom projects, whole school initiatives and opportunities for professional development. The Foundation awards between 15 and 20 innovative grants to teachers and staff totaling more than \$15,000 annually.

Since its inception in 1995, the Glenpool School Foundation for Academic Excellence has funded \$395,000 in grants to teachers.

The Foundation has also awarded over \$40,000 in student scholarships since 2014.

History

The Glenpool Public Schools Foundation for Academic Excellence was founded as a not for profit corporation on February 28, 1994. The Foundation is registered as a 501(3)(c) tax exempt organization which qualifies for tax deductible contributions.

Purpose

The purpose of the Foundation is to stimulate academic excellence and mobilize community support for enhancing the quality of education in the Glenpool Public School system. The Foundation, through fundraising efforts, generates additional dollars from the private sector for the support of the school district.
