Glenpool Allows Discharge of Fireworks on Fourth, Fifth Only

July 2, 2014, GLENPOOL, Okla. – Celebrating the Fourth of July with a bang is a time-honored American tradition, and one people within the city limits of Glenpool enjoy as a part of the Independence Day holiday. The City requires those who intend to set off fireworks during the holiday to have a permit to do so. Permits may be purchased for \$20 and are available at every fireworks stand in Glenpool, at the Glenpool Water Department located at 14526 S. Elwood and at the City Municipal Building on Yukon Avenue behind the Glenpool Walmart.

Fireworks may only be discharged on Friday, the Fourth of July and the day following, by ordinance. Citizens are encouraged to report fireworks violations to the Police Department via the non-emergency number: 918-322-8110.

“We want everyone in Glenpool to enjoy a safe and happy Independence Day, so we encourage all citizens to use fireworks responsibly and with respect for their neighbors,” Roger Kolman, City Manager of the City of Glenpool, said.

The Glenpool Fire Department recommends:

- keeping a bucket of water on hand when lighting fireworks.
- reading and following any directions and safety warnings before using fireworks.
- ensuring a responsible adult supervises any minors participating in celebrations.
- avoiding alcohol consumption mixed with the lighting of fireworks.
