## **Glenpool FOP Receives Lodge of the Year Award**

August 12, 2014, GLENPOOL, Okla. –The Glenpool Carson Noteware Lodge #133 was recently recognized with the 2014 Lodge of the Year Award at the 32nd Biennial Conference of the Oklahoma State Fraternal Order of Police.

Lodge #133 was recognized for its ongoing efforts to raise money and awareness for various local charities including the Glenpool food bank located at Triumph Worship Center and the Glenpool Public Schools Angel Tree. Lodge President Dan Haney and Chaplain Scott Ward were specifically acknowledged for their participation in the first annual Smoke & Guns MMA event which helped raise \$25,000 for the Special Olympics of Oklahoma and the Tulsa Firefighters Burn Camp.
